



Regulations for participation in the Midburn 2025 event (the "event")

The regulations are worded in the masculine language for convenience only, but they are addressed to both women and men.

These regulations constitute an agreement for all intents and purposes between Midbaran Association, A.R. 580567600 ("**the organizer of the event**") and/or a producer on its behalf (the association and/or the producer will be referred to below together and separately: "**the organizers**"), and between each and every one of the ticket purchasers for the event ("**participant**").

You are requested to carefully and carefully read the aforementioned regulations. Your participation in the event constitutes absolute and unconditional agreement to everything stated in the regulations.

If you do not agree to any condition, you are required not to participate in the event and not to purchase this ticket.

Any reference in the regulations to the participant, whether in the first person or in the second person, whether in the singular or in the plural, also includes his minor children and/or anyone accompanying him to the event, and for whom the participant is responsible and/or for his behavior.

For your attention, everything stated in these regulations comes In addition on "[The conditions of participation in the events of the Midbarn Association](#)" Your confirmation of this document constitutes confirmation of your agreement to what is detailed therein.

1. What is a Midburn event?

Once a year, thousands of people gather in the desert to create the City Desert, dedicated to community, art, self-expression, and self-reliance (hereafter "**The temporary city**"). To the melting pot of participation and creativity, everyone is invited.

Midbarn is a dedicated and unique project for the members of the Midbarn community and the Burningman community in Israel and around the world, which takes place in a format based on the "Burning Man" event in Nevada, USA. The project is based on the establishment and existence of a temporary city in the desert for several days, and at the end of the demolition of the city, the removal of all material that does not belong to the place and the return of the city area and the surrounding area to their natural state.

The temporary city is based on the content and actions of the community members and on the ten Burningman principles that guide and lead it. Everything that is created and takes place in it is the result of creation, construction, activity and participation of you and your friends participating in the event. It is the responsibility of the organizers, the vast majority of whom volunteer to create a licensing and safety and administration infrastructure. **It should be emphasized that the organizers are not responsible for the contents, even if they have confirmed their existence.**

As in any other city, the temporary city has a system of essential infrastructures, and

community services that include: city planning, emergency and medical services, safety and security departments, sanitation, etc., and this in order to create and operate enough services and infrastructures to support the structure of the civil organism created mostly by volunteers. **The rest is up to you.**

The inhabitants of the temporary city create, act, participate and exist in spirit [The ten principles](#).

You are required to read these ten principles before coming to the event, and to conduct yourself according to them throughout your stay in the temporary city, and towards all other participants.

Wherever the "event" or "temporary city" is mentioned in these regulations, according to the context, the reference is also to the period of the city's establishment and dissolution.

2. BUYING A TICKET AND CANCELING A TRANSACTION

2.1. Payment on a card will be made by credit card only. It will be clarified that the payment itself is made through system External clearing which will be operated by an external company (hereinafter: "**The clearing company**"). It is clarified that the provisions of the terms of use of the clearing company's website will apply to any purchase made through the clearing company. The association will work to contract with a clearing company that has permission to manage databases and secure them as required by the Privacy Protection Law 5711, 1981 and which operates according to strict security standards.

2.2. Buying a ticket is taking part in the joint community effort to hold the event. The event budget is a joint fund of the community of event participants. therefore:

2.3. in accordance with Consumer protection regulations (cancellation of a transaction), **Cancellation of a transaction by the participant** It will be possible on the site to sell tickets by [Dedicated cancellation form](#), Within 14 days from the date of execution of the transaction, provided That the cancellation be made no later than 7 business days before the date of the event. It is clarified and agreed that the date of the event for the purpose of this section is defined as the date of the start of the establishment of the event in the field, i.e. - **5/11/2025 (hereinafter: "event start date")**.

2.4. After cancellation of the transaction by the buyer as mentioned above, the buyer will be entitled to a refund according to the price actually paid, minus a cancellation fee of 5% of the transaction price. The purchaser and/or anyone on his behalf will not have any claim against the association regarding the aforementioned deduction.

2.5. The refund will be issued to the credit from which it was purchased only.

2.6. **Insofar as the event is canceled for any reason beyond the control of its organizers (hereinafter: "forced cancellation"), and this until day 4/11/2025** The buyer will be entitled to a refund minus cancellation fees and participation in the production costs of the event that will be deducted in the amount of **25% of the transaction price (estimation of the association's expenses up to that time)**, And the buyer and/or anyone on his behalf will not have any claim against the association regarding the aforementioned deduction.

- 2.7. **As much as the event will be forced cancellation, in the period between Day 5/11/2025 (date of landing) until 11/23/2025 at midnight, (the day before the city gates open)** The buyer will be entitled to a refund minus cancellation fees and participation fees for the costs of producing the event that went down the drain, in the total amount of - **50% of the transaction price (estimation of the association's expenses up to that time.** The purchaser and/or anyone on his behalf will not have any claim against the association regarding the aforementioned deduction.
 - 2.8. **As much as the event will cancel a forced cancellation from the day 24/11/2025 (opening day) and onwards,** and/or will be terminated after its commencement, the buyer will not be entitled to any refund.
 - 2.9. Notwithstanding the above, in any case of force majeure/force majeure cancellation, the organizers will make an effort to reduce the damage and refund the ticket buyers the maximum possible cost.
 - 2.10. For the avoidance of doubt, the administrators of the site and/or the association and the organizers of the event will not be responsible for any direct or indirect damage, financial or otherwise, caused to the purchaser as a result of purchasing the tickets on the site and/or as a result of canceling or postponing an event, and any reliance on the holding of the events on the dates being prepared is the sole responsibility of the purchaser.
 - 2.11. The card is personal and can be transferred only subject to the terms of card transfer, in a dedicated form published by the association and with its approval, and this, until and no later than **7 business days** before the start date of the event, as defined above, **ie -13/11/2025** After this date, no transfer of tickets will be allowed.
3. Entry to the event
 - 3.1. Entry of participants to the event will be possible from the time the gates open, as will be announced.
 - 3.2. Early entry to the event will be possible for authorized participants such as: the production team, the MPF team (public projects department), for participants in the establishment of theme camps according to a key and lists that have been forwarded in advance, for those setting up an art installation according to a key and lists that have been forwarded in advance, to various volunteers and authorized suppliers, whose early entry has been approved in advance by the production team and whose details have been forwarded to the ticket and gate departments. Early arrival approval will be subject to filling out Ticket and gate department instructions.
 - 3.3. Entry is conditional upon presentation of a personal entry card, identification of the participant through an identification card and matching of the identification card with the purchaser's details appearing on the card. Without a match between these - entry will not be possible.
 4. settlement
 - 4.1. After entering the city you will meet the welcoming team ("**Greeters**") that will greet you and, among other things, give you the map of the city. The city map shows the streets of the city, the theme camps, marked locations for parking and free camping, and other important and relevant information. Using the map, you will be able to locate your camp and find your way around the event. For your information, it is absolutely forbidden to park your vehicle or set up a campsite outside the designated areas.
 - 4.2. For your information, the movement of vehicles (with the exception of authorized

vehicles) is prohibited in the territory of the temporary city. Therefore, if you wish to leave the event before its end, you will have to park in advance in the designated parking lot.

5. Leaving the event area

For your information, it is absolutely forbidden to enter the city area with a vehicle for the purpose of loading equipment before the end of the event and police approval for the entry of vehicles.

6. Installations and art in the temporary city

6.1. The temporary city we are building is dedicated to total self-expression and art, installations (art installation - any type of sculpture or art placed at the event), performances, theme camps and unique costumes at the event. This is the perfect place to give free rein to creativity and allow creation without limits and without limitations. The art created at the event is not commercial, is not commissioned and does not carry any branding.

6.2. If you are interested in setting up an art installation at the event, you will have to register and get permission in advance from the organizers and act in accordance with their instructions and fill out the registration forms on the agreed published dates.

6.3. Burning an art installation is allowed only with the prior approval of the organizers, and under their management.

7. Theme camps - **Theme Camps**

Theme camps are an integral part of the fabric that creates the event. Unlike regular camps that are designed to provide existential services to their members (accommodation, food, etc.), a themed camp also provides a space that invites other participants to come and enjoy certain content activities. Such as: music, dances, workshops, relaxation space, creative space and the like.

If you intend to set up a theme camp, you will have to plan in advance and take into account every possible safety aspect in connection with it, it is your responsibility to take care of and bring with you everything necessary for setting up, dismantling and maintaining the camp in a safe and responsible manner, while preventing any risk to the participants and guests.

8. Living conditions at the event

8.1. For your attention, the temporary city will be built in the desert, under the dome of the sky, where extreme weather conditions may prevail even in the summer months, including dramatic temperature differences between day and night, and sometimes even sand and dust storms.

8.2. On Midburn's internet and Facebook pages you can find a lot of additional information that will allow you to get ready and get organized. **You are required to read the guide carefully and prepare with its help for the event.**

9. safety

9.1. **Personal safety** - First of all take care of yourself! To remind you, you are building your temporary home in the desert and therefore you must make sure to drink enough

water under these conditions. Be careful of exposure to the sun, equip yourself with warm clothing at night, listen to your needs and the demands of your body, keep your work safe during the setting up and dismantling of your camp; At night, illuminate yourself and your surroundings with adequate lighting; Pay attention to objects, pegs, strings and anything else that could endanger your safety.

- 9.2. **safety Your camp/encampment** – Establishing a camp or encampment in the temporary city may be accompanied by many safety risks, such as: pegs, poles, bezants, shading nets and other facilities brought or to be erected by you, use of tools, electricity, gas, and fire or other risk factors arising from staying there. In addition, extreme conditions and strong winds may arise in the temporary city that could blow away anything that is not properly connected and secured and pose a risk and safety hazard. **You must take all necessary measures to prevent these dangers and familiarize yourself with the safety procedures that will be published.**
- 9.3. **Safety of stabilizers, installations and subject camps** - The establishment and/or operation of a bear camp or installation in the temporary city may be accompanied by additional safety risks, such as but not limited to: falling, collapse, electrocution, overcrowding, and any other risk arising from them. Therefore, if you are planning or participating in the establishment of an installation, facility or bear camp, it is your responsibility to take care of the establishment, operation, maintenance and dismantling of the installation, facility or bear camp in a safe and responsible manner and in accordance with the safety procedures that will be published, while preventing any risk to you and other participants throughout the event.

If you received permission to set up an installation, facility or theme camp in the temporary city, you must act in accordance with the instructions of the organizers and the safety consultant on their behalf, and the responsibility **the full** Everything related to its safety (including its establishment and dismantling) is your responsibility.

- 9.4. **fire safety** - It is strictly forbidden to light bonfires in the territory of the temporary city without the permission of the organizers. Lighting a fire with permission will only be done in suitable facilities (half a barrel) and in a controlled manner under the close supervision of a responsible adult.
- 9.5. **Safety in construction/dismantling work** - When performing such works, you must act according to safety instructions as they will be distributed and published in connection with this.

10. participation

Participation is an integral part of the event experience and the participants are the ones who build the temporary city, admire it and finally take care of dismantling it. In order to participate in the construction of the city and its operation, you must register [here](#), And depending on the need, you will be contacted by the various departments. **Please note, it is not possible to volunteer in the city departments without registering on this form.**

During the event, there may be an additional requirement to participate in various roles; If you wish to participate during the event, you can contact the temporary city center and register there.

11. Medical treatment

in general, We recommend that at all times during your stay in the temporary city you will be insured with appropriate insurance coverage regarding your participation in the event. A volunteer clinic will be operated in the temporary city, the purpose of which is to provide medical assistance to those attending the event, in addition to the medical system required by the licensing regulations. In the event that you need medical treatment, you have the choice to seek medical treatment from the clinic's medical staff or to independently seek other medical treatment, outside the event premises. **If you choose to use the clinic's services, you release and release the clinic's volunteers and organizers from responsibility for all the consequences of this medical treatment, whatever they may be.**

12. Exclusion from association events

It is clarified and agreed that Midbaran reserves the right to immediately remove from the event and even from future events, permanently, any person who did not act in accordance with the organizers' instructions, including according to these regulations and/or the general event regulations of the Midbaran association, including those who are reported or suspected of having engaged in violence and/or sexual violence and/or sexual harassment and/or those who are found to have entered the event without a permit or fraudulently and/or those who are not He has a card that matches his ID card, or he does not have a bracelet that correctly verifies the purchase of a card in his name.

The Midburn Association and/or anyone on its behalf will not reimburse the excluded person for the payment of the ticket, or any damage claimed by him for his exclusion from the event.

13. The local jurisdiction for all matters related to the event and these regulations will be in the competent court in the district of Tel-Aviv - Jaffa.
